Toll Bros. begins presales of Heritage Glen homes

Toll Bros. recently began presales at its newest neighborhood in Summerlin, Heritage Glen.

Located within the community's The Willow Creek village, the guard-gated property features greenbelts, walking paths, basketball and tennis courts, and a gazebo.

A total of 85 homes will be built, ranging from 3,350 to 4,300 square feet. Home sites start at 10,000 square feet.

Standard features include granite kitchen counter tops, upgraded appliances and spa tubs in owner baths.

Prices start in the high \$300,000s.

To visit, take Sahara Avenue to Town Center Drive and go south to Havenwood Lane.

The neighborhood is open Thursdays through Mondays from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Tuesdays and Wednesdays by appointment.

Toll Bros. has four other developments within Summerlin: Wood Glen, Willow Glen, Oak Hill and Woodlands. The builder is also developing Buckingham at Queensridge and Stonehaven at MacDonald Highlands.
